SESHL code of conduct

The mission of the Southeast Sled Hockey League is to provide structured, competitive hockey for sled hockey teams in the southeastern United States. SESHl provides an environment where individual with and without disabilities can participate. The league emphasizes community, commitment, teamwork, sportsmanship, and growth. SESHl will support the growth of sled hockey through competition, player development, and community.

In order to serve the mission, the SESHl has instituted this 'Code of Conduct' for all Players, Coaches, Team Officials, Volunteers and Fans (collectively, "Participants").

Additionally, the SESHl follows USA Hockey's Zero Tolerance Policy requiring all Participants to maintain a sportsmanlike and safe atmosphere before, during and after all games ([Zero Tolerance Policy](#)) and anyone participating in, or attending, our games or any activities related to the games or the League, is required to act in accordance with this policy both on and off the ice.

SPORTSMANSHIP

All Participants are expected to conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner. Respect teammates, coaches, team officials, referees, opponents, opposing coaches, opposing team officials and other participants in SESHl games, practices, and other related activities.

CONDUCT OUTSIDE OF LEAGUE ACTIVITIES

Inappropriate conduct and comments, whether verbal or written including on social media, may reflect negatively on the League and could subject you or your team to disciplinary action from the League.

OFFICIALS

The Officials are the given the power to run games. Officials decisions are final and cannot be appealed during the game. A Teams Bench Coach, or Team Captain are the only approved parties to communicate with Officials during a game.

DISCIPLINARY ACTION

The SESHl Director and SESHl Team Board reserves the right to suspend, censure or otherwise discipline any Team, Team Official, Coach, Player, Volunteer, Fan, etc. who is deemed to have violated any part of this Code of Conduct and the below Player Commitment.
